CYBER SHOCK-2

With the objective of improving the cyber security readiness to counter cyber threats in Power sector, Indian Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT-In) successfully conducted "Cyber Shock -2", a Cyber Exercise based on Cyber-attack and defence on IT & ICS/OT Network and Advanced Cyber Exercise & competition for Power Sector utilities from 5th July – 10th July & 12th July.



Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Hon'ble Minister of State in the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship; and Minister of State in the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology interacted with exercise team and observed the live cyber security simulation exercise "CyberShock-2" at CERT-In.
